

## 31st Annual AREUEA Doctoral Session 2018

*Application Deadline: Friday, October 13, 2017*

**What:** The AREUEA Doctoral Session provides students in real estate and related fields with insights to topics such as career planning, publishing, and research. Selected students can present their work and all participants can network with peers, journal editors, established Ph.D.s and potential mentors. Student poster session presenters receive a three year complementary AREUEA membership which includes a subscription to *Real Estate Economics*.

**When:** Thursday, January 4, 2018

**Where:** Hotel TBA – Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

**Format:** The poster session will follow comments by leaders in the field. Students presenting their work will prepare a display (i.e. poster, battery-powered computer screens, figures, tables, and charts) highlighting the motivation, methods, and major conclusions from their doctoral research. The students will stand by their display to discuss their research with attendees. The reception will attract an audience!

**Funding:** AREUEA has funds available to defray some travel costs for students who do not have other means of support (e.g. doctoral program travel funds from your school, etc.). Certain limits apply to travel awards. The maximum award for any individual is \$1,000. There is one lifetime award per student. Award priority will be extended to those students presenting in the poster session and whose academic advisor is a current AREUEA member. Priority in funding will also be based on students' progress toward a completed dissertation. Funds are distributed after the conference following submission of travel receipts.
