Submissions are encouraged that highlight pressing issues in real estate finance, urban economics, residential and commercial markets, policy and industry applications, and more. The National Conference is a multidisciplinary forum that uses the Washington DC location to bring together researchers, policy makers, and industry practitioners to present current research on subjects and policy issues that affect the real estate industry. The meeting offers the opportunity to exchange ideas, network with colleagues and gather feedback from peers.

Authors may submit papers or well developed abstracts but preference will be given to completed manuscripts. Submissions can be methodologically rigorous or more policy/practice-oriented in nature.

Submissions

All submissions must be transmitted via the AREUEA conference website. The submission portal is now open. Go to <http://www.areuea.org/conferences/papers.phtml>, select "On-line Submission," and specify "2016 National Conference."

Submissions should include the full contact information (name, affiliation, address, phone, fax, and email) for the corresponding author in addition to the names and affiliations of all co-authors. The submitting author must be an AREUEA member.

Before submitting, please also note the dates of the conference and be sure you will be able to attend and present the paper if it is accepted.
