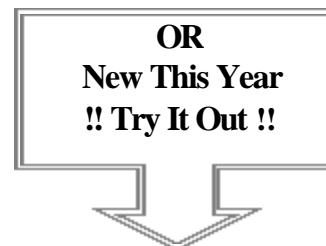
January 3-5, 2003

- Members of the American Real Estate and Urban Economics Association (AREUEA) are invited to submit papers for the AREUEA annual meetings, to be held in conjunction with the Allied Social Science Association (ASSA) meetings.
- The AREUEA meetings will be held in Washington, DC on January 3-5, 2003. Events will include a general membership meeting, twenty paper sessions, and a special program for doctoral students. One paper session will be jointly sponsored by the American Economic Association and another by the American Finance Association. The topical focus of the sessions will include: theoretical and empirical research in real estate economics, real estate finance, and urban economics.
- Those interested in having a paper considered for presentation should submit two copies of a completed manuscript with an abstract, or two copies of a well-developed abstract, no later than **April 1, 2002**. Papers *and* abstracts should include a list of references that is as complete as possible. All submissions should include the full name(s) of the author(s) and their professional affiliation(s). The corresponding author should be clearly identified with information on his or her: current address, telephone number, FAX number, and an e-mail address. This information should appear only on the title page of the submission. At least one author must be a member of AREUEA. The abstract page should include a list of keywords indicating the contents of the article.
