Getting to the University of Denver:

The university is 5 miles from downtown however; transportation is simple as the Denver Metro light rail system runs from downtown Denver right through the Denver Convention Center to the university's light rail stop. This is a 12 minute ride and costs \$3 round trip – tickets can be purchased at any light rail station. Once off the light rail the Richie Center is 2 blocks east of the light rail and is easily identified by the high gold steeple on the building. DU students will be there to guide AREUEA members to the event.

For those driving take I-25 south and exit University Avenue - at the first light on University take a right on Buctell Blvd and the Richie Center is 1/2 block on the left.
